Day 1

You will be picked up from your hotel for your transfer to Bogotá airport.

Flight Bogotá - Leticia

Day 1

Flight from Bogotá to Leticia with Avianca.

Pristine jungle where groups of monkeys watch you from the treetops, where you can swim with pink dolphins in Lake Tarapoto and where you sleep with the sounds of the jungle: the Amazon, one of the greatest destinations in Colombia. The gigantic area of 643 thousand square kilometers covers one third of the territory of Colombia and has eight sparsely populated departments where indigenous peoples still live far away from our 'modern' world. You fly to Leticia, capital of the Amazonas department, on the border with Brazil and Peru. This chaotic jungle city, which can only be accessed by water or air, is the gateway to the indigenous communities and the deepest ecological shelters of the jungle. Hike and navigate the jungle and marvel at the abundance of wildlife, learn about the traditions of indigenous communities and listen to the jungle from your hammock. Tourism in this area is still relatively underdeveloped, which makes a visit to the Colombian Amazon very special.

It is recommended to wear long sleeves and long pants as well as trekking boots or rubber boots and a small trekking backpack to carry water, raincoat and basic supplies, remember that in the jungle rainshowers are constant and unexpected.

4 Days tour Calanoa

Day 1:

A Calanoa guide will pick you up at Leticia airport to transport you to the lodge, a 60-kilometre journey across the vast Amazon River. You will stay in comfortable eco-friendly bungalows built with natural materials and native architecture, with palm leaf roofs and wooden floors and furniture. The canopied beds have a mosquito net and each bungalow has a loft with hammocks and a private bathroom. Freshly prepared organic meals are included during your stay. The lodge is located directly on the Amazon River, in a private nature reserve where the owners have established a project for sustainable community-based tourism and conservation. In the evening, a local guide will take you on a night walk in the jungle, where you will hear and see how the jungle comes alive at night with the sound of numerous insects, frogs, owls, monkeys and mushrooms lighting up in the dark jungle.

Day 2:

After breakfast, you will visit one of the native communities in the area, where you will get an insight into the life of the natives as it relates to the water and the surrounding jungle. After lunch back at the lodge, a local guide will take you on a walk through the jungle of the reserve, where you will learn about the use of local plants. When water conditions permit, a canoe will pick you up to paddle through the forest at high tide back to the lodge. A special experience.

Day 3:

In the morning you will visit the community of Mocagua in the Amacayacu National Park, where you will see a lake with the largest lotus flowers in the world. In the afternoon you will navigate to the Peruvian border in search of pink dolphins, and watch the sunset with all its colours from the water of the Amazon River. As an optional activity, you can visit the Peruvian community Vista Alegre.

Day 4:

After breakfast, you will travel back to Leticia by boat at the required time depending on your flight and in consultation with Calanoa. When you arrive in Leticia you will take a taxi to the airport.

Other optional activities include a visit to the village of Puerto Nariño and Lake Tarapoto, and a visit to a monkey reserve in the Calanoa area. You can also go canoeing and participate in a ritual with a local shaman.



Hotel Calanoa

3 Nights



Calanoa is a jungle hotel located in the reserve that bears the same name, between Amacayacu National Park and the island of Mocagua. In the Calanoa reserve you will find a river, streams and lakes where you can observe the diversity in fauna and flora. The hotel has cabins that use local architecture with palms and wood, and they have private bathrooms. In the reserve it is also possible to enjoy activities such as recreational fishing, hiking through the jungle, birdwatching or participating

in the preparation of meals that are a fusion of the traditional Amazonian cuisine of Colombia, Peru and Brazil.

What to bring?

- Good hiking shoes
- Flip flops or extra pair of footwear
- Clothing for warm and humid weather, also with long sleeves (protection against sun and mosquitoes)
- Lots of socks
- Something warm for the night (jacket or sweater)
- Bathing suit and towel
- Mackintosh / poncho
- Reusable hard water bottle for refills
- Sunscreen and mosquito repellent
- Hat or cap
- Torch and extra batteries
- Camera
- Personal medicines and first aid

Note: Yellow fever vaccination is recommended in this area. Take your vaccination booklet with you. In addition, a tourist tax must be paid on arrival at Leticia airport (+/- 35,000 COP). Rain boots are available in different sizes up to 45.
