ITINERARY

Bogotá

In the Andes, at 2600 meters altitude, we find Colombia's capital, Bogotá, with an estimated 9 million inhabitants. With residents from all around the globe and a thriving cultural scene, Bogotá is a city that has a lot to offer. The metropolis has several museums, such as the Gold Museum, the National Museum and the Botero Museum, where you can immerse yourself in Colombian history and culture. In addition, Bogotá is known for its graffiti street art. Amazing murals that often portray a political or historical message can be found throughout the city. Bogotá is also a popular city among cycling enthusiasts; nowhere else in Latin America will you find more bike paths in the city, and consequently the bicycle is a frequently seen means of transport. Most travellers go to the Candelaria district, the beautiful colonial centre of Bogota where it is enjoyable to stroll around the sloping streets with their colourful colonial houses. To the north, there are more posh, modern neighbourhoods, with world-class restaurants, as well as cocktail bars and cafés.

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Amazonas

The Colombian Amazon is an exuberant territory that covers more than 35% of the country and is a paradise for nature and adventure lovers. With an incomparable biodiversity, it is home to a tenth of the known species of the planet. The arrival is through Leticia, capital of the department of Amazonas, on the border with Brazil and Perú. The chaotic jungle town, accessible only by water or air, is the gateway to indigenous communities and the jungle's deepest eco-lodges. Learn about the traditions of the indigenous communities and listen to the jungle from your hammock. Tourism in this area is still relatively undeveloped, which makes a visit to the Colombian Amazon very special; tourists can participate in ancestral rituals, learn about traditional medicine, enjoy native dances and songs, and sample the local cuisine.

It is recommended to wear long sleeves and long pants as well as hiking boots or rubber boots and a small trekking backpack to carry water, raincoat and basic necessities, remember that in the jungle the rains are constant and unexpected.

Note: Yellow fever vaccine is recommended for this area. In addition, a tourist tax must be paid in cash upon arrival at the airport in Leticia (+/- 45,000 COP, 2024).

5-day tour Ecolodge Palmari

Day 1: A local guide will pick you up at Leticia airport and assist you with the migration procedure for the border crossing to Brazil. There you will travel by boat to the Palmari Nature Reserve and Ecolodge, a 4 to 5 hour trip on the river. Dinner and overnight at the lodge.

Day 2: You are free to spend the day with a selection of the following activities: swimming in natural pools, traditional tattoos, mud baths at the spa, day or night jungle walks, fishing, caiman watching, visits to local communities and more. All activities are guided by local Spanish and Portuguese speaking guides. All activities are included and can be repeated. Sometimes groups are formed with other travellers for a particular activity. Breakfast, lunch and dinner at the lodge.

Day 3: Today you are free to complete the day with activities of your choice. Breakfast, lunch and dinner at the lodge.

Day 4: Today you are free to complete the day with activities of your choice. Breakfast, lunch and dinner at the lodge.

Day 5: After breakfast, you will depart by boat for the return trip to Leticia (+/- 4 hours plus land transport to Leticia). The guide will help you with the migration procedure, after which you will be taken to the airport for your flight back to Bogota.



Reserva Natural Palmari

4 Nights



The Palmari Nature Reserve is located +/- 5 hours navigating through the Amazon river and its tributaries from Leticia. The accommodation consists of cabins with their own bathroom and a private terrace. It also has a communal Maloka and a hammock area with shared bathrooms. To move around the visitor center you must go over elevated bridges, and there is a lookout tower overlooking the Javari river and the surrounding forests.

The reserve has natural pools, a beach in dry season, you can go canoeing and kayaking, there is a traditional mud spa traditional, you can go fishing, birdwatching, see dolphins and crocodiles, take boat rides to towns on the Brazilian and Peruvian side, play ping pong and table football, children's games and you can make traditional crafts, etc.

Please note: the reserve is located in Brazil, so you should consult the Brazilian consulate in your city of origin if you require a tourist visa. The yellow fever vaccine is mandatory.

What to bring?

- Good hiking shoes
- Flip flops or extra pair of footwear
- Clothing for warm and humid weather, also with long sleeves (protection against sun and mosquitoes)
- Lots of socks - Something warm for the night (jacket or sweater)
- Bathing suit and towel - Mackintosh / poncho
- Reusable hard water bottle for refills
- Sunscreen and mosquito repellent
- Hat or cap
- Torch and extra batteries
- Camera
- Personal medicines and first aid

Note: Yellow fever vaccination is recommended in this area. Take your vaccination booklet with you. In addition, a tourist tax must be paid on arrival at Leticia airport (+/- 45,000 COP, 2024). Rain boots are available in different sizes up to 45.
